P.G. course content has been designed with the twin objective of enabling the students to have an in-depth knowledge in Economic Theory and Practice as well as to give an exposure to real world applications. The theory papers are structured in such a way that there is a balance between economic theory and its application.

Adequate importance has been given to viewing the Indian Economy from a policy perspective, to apply the principles for understanding the macro economic model building of the Indian Economy. With the advent of economic liberalisation there have been plethora of changes in Indian policy making. The course content of all the papers includethese changes. The course has incorporated quantitative tools and techniques by Papers on Applied Mathematics, Applied Statistics, Econometrics to complement the theory papers which help the students in their project work.

Paper on "Economics of Social Issues" encourage students to take up Projects on Health, Education Poverty, Environment, Women, Education etc.

To equip and motivate the students for self-employment, the department offers the following papers as skill based subject, Analytical Reasoning Levels I, II and III

Project work is a compulsory part of the course content for P.G. The students are provided with an opportunity to pursue fieldwork in specific areas for the project work. The project work gains special significance because of the department's tie up with the leading research institutes in the city. This has enabled the department to gain access to the research experience of experts from these institutes.
