The Master of Philosophy in Economics Programme is designed to provide a solid foundation for advanced knowledge in Economics. The Programme combines a study of core subjects to a high level offered as Economic Theory, Research Methodology and the opportunity to study specialised field subjects offered as Optional Paper. The course on Economic Theory provides a comprehensive training in economics theory, its techniques and applications. A course on Research Methodology offers Quantitative and Qualitative methods that are used to perform research operations. The optional courses are designed to develop knowledge and understanding of theory, techniques and debates within the field of specialised subjects. A dissertation is submitted by the M.Phil scholars which receives grades. The experience of writing a research paper provides an excellent foundation for a career as a professional economist in Public Service or Private sector. For those planning to progress to a Doctorate, the Programme provides a high level analytical training.
